2027 Prohibited List

Introduction - Substances of Abuse

- The wording was changed to clarify that the presence of metabolites for *Substances of Abuse* should be taken into consideration in the results management process when relevant.

SUBSTANCES AND METHODS PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES (IN- AND OUT-OF-COMPETITION)

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

S0. Non-approved substances

- Many peptides, not approved for human use by regulatory authorities, fulfill the criteria of the World Anti-Doping Code for inclusion on the *Prohibited List* and fall under the S0 (Non-Approved Substances) class, or other classes (such as S2 or S4). Even if a peptide is not specifically named on the List, utmost caution should be taken as it may still be prohibited and may be harmful to health. In this regard, for clarity, peptides are now named as examples in this section.

S4. Hormone and Metabolic Modulators

- The title of section S4.2 was expanded to reflect current terminology for substances in this class.
- Imlunestrant was added as an example in section S4.2.
- Seladelpar was added as an example of PPAR-delta agonist.
- SLU-PP-332 and SLU-PP-915 were added as examples of metabolic modulators acting particularly on oxidative metabolism.

S5. Diuretics and Masking Agents

- Eplerenone and finerenone were added as examples.

SUBSTANCES AND METHODS PROHIBITED IN-COMPETITION

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

S8. Cannabinoids

- The changes were made to reflect current scientific knowledge on the delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol (Δ^9 -THC) like-effects of commonly encountered cannabinoids.
- Cannabidiol is not prohibited. However, cannabidiol extracted from cannabis plants may also contain varying concentrations of THC, which remains a prohibited substance.

S9. Glucocorticoids

- Vaginal administration was added as a permitted route.

SUBSTANCES PROHIBITED IN PARTICULAR SPORTS

P1. Beta-Blockers

- To be consistent with other federations in this section, the reference to “all disciplines” was removed from WCBS.



MONITORING PROGRAM

- The following substances were removed as sufficient information has been collected:
 - codeine;
 - dermorphin and its analogues;
 - hydrocodone and
 - fentanyl and tramadol *Out-of-Competition*.
